Casselton Public Library's Facebook Page is a place for patrons to share opinions about library related subjects/issues. Comments are welcome but will be reviewed by the Library Director for:

- Potentially libelous comments
- Obscene comments
- Racist comments and hate speech
- Personal attacks, insults, or threatening language
- Plagiarized material
- Private/personal information published without consent
- Comments unrelated to the topic of the forum
- Commercial promotion, advertisements, or spam
- Hyperlinks to material that is not directly related to the discussion

By posting a comment you agree to indemnify the Casselton Public Library and its Board of Directors and employees from and against all liabilities, judgments, damages, and costs (including attorney's fees) incurred by any of them which arise out of or are related to the content that you post.

Forums and messaging may not be used for commercial purposes or for organized political activity.

The Casselton Public Library reserves the right to monitor all content before it is posted, and to modify or remove any messages or postings that it deems, on its sole discretion, to be abusive, defamatory, in violation of the copyright, trademark right, or other intellectual property right of any third party, or otherwise inappropriate.
